## **Stepping Stones**

Applications for pupils joining in September are considered during the Summer Term. Pupils wishing to join at other times are considered following their second birthday as vacancies arise. A separate application form is required should you wish to apply for Eastcourt School at the same time.

Successful applicants are notified in writing, and places are reserved on receipt of a non-refundable deposit of £100. The deposit is credited against the final fees payment provided the correct notice is given.

# **Breakfast/After School Care/Holiday Clubs**

Applications are considered as received. Places are offered on a first come/first served basis.

Fees are paid monthly by cash or cheque, based on 51 weeks per year and are due by the 6<sup>th</sup> of the month. The Centre closes for Bank Holidays and for one week over Christmas/New Year. We make no allowance for absence due to family holidays or sickness: you are paying for the space, not the period your child attends. Funding is spread over the whole year and covers eleven hours per week. Individual monthly fees are communicated in writing before you start at Stepping Stones. No further bills are issued unless there is a change in fees due. Reminders are sent for late payments, and will include penalties.

#### **Optional extras**

Between the hours of 7.30am and 8am we offer additional care, charged at £3 per half hour.

#### **Transport**

Transport to drop off and collect from Eastcourt School, Goodmayes, can be arranged at 8.45am and 3.30pm. This arrangement is included where fees are charged at the all-day rate.

#### Late payment

Penalties are charged for late payment or returned cheques, as follows:

- 1. Late payments are charged at £10 per week
- 2. Parents will be asked to pay £10 for any cheque that is returned.

#### **Notice of Withdrawal or Change of Hours**

Once the parent or guardian has accepted the offer of a place in Stepping Stones, s/he is required to give the Manager, in writing, at least one full month's notice of the withdrawal, or for a change of hours for the pupil concerned, whether or not they have joined. Failing this, payment of the fees for the following month will be due. In the event of the Manager requiring a pupil to be withdrawn from Stepping Stones, no part of the current month's fee will be refunded.

Sessions are arranged half termly and fees adjusted according to the number of weeks involved. Invoices are issued two weeks before the end of the previous session with payment due one week later.

Any remaining places are allocated on a first-come first-served basis.

Applications for set days each week (days cannot vary from week to week) will be charged at a rate of £12.50 per day 3.30-6pm (including food) or £4 per day 4.45-5.45pm (activity session only). Transport (from Eastcourt School, Goodmayes) is offered at a rate of £2.50 per day.

Confirmation of your booking together with an invoice will be sent to you on receipt of your application. Invoices for activity weeks/days should be settled two weeks before the date the sessions start. Individual sessions, charged at a rate of £4 per hour, will also be considered subject to availability. Breakfast club is available at a rate of £5 (8-9am), £6.50 (7.30-9am) per day. Extended day till 6pm available at a rate of £5 per day.

Reception will be charged at pre-school rates as the adult: child ratio and curriculum must be the same by law.

#### Late payment

Penalties are charged for late payment or returned cheques, as follows:

- 1. Late payments are charged at £10 per week
- 2. Parents will be asked to pay Bank Charges caused by cheque irregularities.

#### **Notice of Withdrawal**

Once the parent or guardian has accepted the offer of a place he/she is required to give the manager, in writing, at least one full month's notice of the withdrawal of the pupil concerned. In the event of the Manager requiring a pupil to be withdrawn from The Oaks no part of the current month's fee will be refunded.

# Terms of acceptance of a pupil to Stepping Stones at the Oaks Activity Centre

By signing the Application, parents or guardians confirm that they have read, understood and agreed to the following terms:

- 1. Children are expected to obey the rules and must pay strict attention to speech, appearance, courtesy and general conduct.
- 2. Children are expected to take a full part in the corporate life and activities of the centre.
- 3. Children must attend regularly and punctually. No child is to be absent except in the case of illness. Holidays during term-time are discouraged.
- 4. If a child is absent because of illness, the centre must be informed by 9.15am on the first day of absence. On returning, a written explanation (for our files) needs to be submitted.
- 5. Children suffering from an infectious disease, or who have been in contact with infection, must not return until certified clear of the infection by a doctor.
- 6. All monthly fees are payable (by cheque or cash) by the sixth day of each month. No remission can be claimed for absence. We reserve the right to charge a fee for late payments.
- 7. Notice, in writing, must be given at least one calendar month before the withdrawal of a child. This applies whether or not the child has joined the Oaks, once the offer of a place has been accepted.
- 8. The Oaks reserves the right of accepting or refusing a child and of requiring a child to be withdrawn.
- 9. The Manager reserves the right to take appropriate action in respect of breaches of our rules or other misbehaviour, and to delegate responsibility for good discipline to members of staff.
